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
Dear Parents and Caregivers:

Your child has applied for the St. Tammany Parish dual enrollment program through Career Technical Education. This program earns your child credit hours for Salmen as well as Northshore Technical Community College. The classes offered at Salmen High School include auto tech, drafting, medical terminology, Emergency Medical Technician, Emergency Medical Responder, Certified Nursing Assistant and ProStart for culinary arts. The credits for these classes often transfer to a student's first year of college and can be essential to beginning a career.

The goal for this program is to ensure that your child is given the opportunity to have a real life experience in the career path they choose. Students in drafting use the program AutoCAD to create drawings and then use a 3D printer to make them a reality. In our Certified Nursing Assistant course, students visit hospitals and learn day to day operations of the facility. In all of the career technical pathways, students are allowed to have unique job experiences and apply them to their future careers.
